Cookies are small data files stored on or read from a device by a website or service. Similar technologies include local storage, tags, scripts, device identifiers and server-side logs. They can support security, functionality, preference storage, performance measurement and advertising. A service can also process technical information without setting a cookie.

Legal basis and consent

Strictly necessary technologies are used to provide and secure the website and forms. Refusing optional technologies will not prevent access to essential website content, although a related optional feature may not work.

Managing cookies

Most browsers allow users to view, block or delete cookies and to restrict third-party storage. Browser controls differ by product and version. Blocking essential security or delivery technologies may prevent a form or page from working correctly. A user may also adjust any consent tool made available on the website when optional technologies are introduced.

Third party services

Third-party services used for security, content delivery or other approved functions process information under their own terms and privacy notices. PreMo assesses providers and configures services to limit processing to what is reasonably necessary, but it does not control every aspect of a third-party service. Retention

Cookie durations depend on purpose and provider configuration. Session cookies expire when the browser session ends; persistent cookies remain until their set expiry or deletion. Server and security logs are retained only for operational, security, legal and evidentiary periods considered necessary under PreMo retention controls.

PreMo will update this Notice before or when materially changing the website technologies described here. The published version will identify its effective date. If a new optional technology requires consent, the website will present the relevant choice rather than relying only on an updated document.
